
ULTIMAX LINE ISOLATOR

The ULTIMAX is the best solution to fight RFI interference which can cause many issues at your station, in some locations those problems can be from TX audio been distorted, RF bites when touching the microphone connector in your radio, hearing your TX audio thru your PC speakers, Tripping the GFI outlets in your house and many others.

Placing a few line Isolators inside your station can help with most of those issues, plus it also helps with reducing some man made noise which your coax shield could be picking up from a nearby source.

If you run an amplifier at your station placing one after the amp will be ideal to fight most common mode, also placing one before the radio's input will help removing some noise before it enters the radio, look at the example below.

Make sure to keep the enclosure straight to keep the weep holes pointing straight down to avoid any water to enter unit if you decide to use outside.
